- 1. What was that website address again (to access QuickSight)?
 - A idm.cms.gov
- 2. I see the map at bottom, can it geocode addresses to longitude/latitude? And does it have access to several geographic layers?

 A You have the ability to drill down and zoom in based upon the level of granularity of your data,
- 3. Who can to get an access Dashboard Creator?
 - A To request access, follow the instructions here on Confluence: Requesting & Getting Access. Also, reference the recording to know more on how to sign up.
- 4. Does a consumer need to have a HARP ID or could it be someone that does not have access to the IDM applications? For example, a non-analyst at our QIN, or even a hospital lead that we are working with.
 - A For now, the individual would need a HARP ID or EUA ID to access QuickSight. There is an option to share a dashboard with those who do not
- 5. Is it possible to export out a dashboard and then import it into a different instance of a quicksight account?
 - A We have done this once, but it is extremely difficult because QuickSight requires having access to the data source and datasets in order to recreate an analysis. QuickSight Team can work with groups with specific use cases.
- 6. Please remember that some of us that want a Quicksight role- are already the SO for our State. We cannot approve our own access. A If an organization has two SOs, one would approve the other.
