Planned Actions: On Wednesday, June 29, the Splunk team is requesting all ADOs turn on their Splunk Universal Forwarders, preferably in the morning.

Impacted Application Development Organizations (ADOs): All ADOs and Ventech

Planned Downtime: The only outage expected is to the Splunk Universal Forwarders as they are turned on.

What To Expect: The current version is 8.2.2 and we are planning to upgrade to 9.0.0. Throughout the day, we are planning to perform an upgrade to mitigate a vulnerability communicated by Splunk support. We need the forwarders turned on so we are able to upgrade them. There is no outage associated with this upgrade except to the Universal Forwarders when you bring them online and we perform the upgrade. We will send another memo to let you know when you can shut down your Splunk Universal Forwarders.
