

# **Onboarding into Services**

## Contractor Onboarding into QualityNet IT Services

Once the contract has been awarded, the process begins to onboard new users into QualityNet IT Services. This is a three-step process that involves multiple players.

**Step One:** The COR and New Contractor create an engagement request to identify the type of work to be performed and the services required.

**Step Two:** The Contact Engagement Team conducts an interview with the COR and New Contractor to confirm eligibility for these services and sends a request for approval of these services to the CMS Service Leads for processing.

**Step Three:** After the CMS Service Leads have processed the request, the PM3 Contract Engagement Team prepares and sends a welcome package to the New Contractor's Security Official (SO) to complete the engagement process. The welcome package includes the following information:

- List of SO Responsibilities
- List of Approved Services
- Description of Approved Services
- Instructions for Onboarding Users

Upon receipt of this welcome package and informational materials, the New Contractor SO can begin the process of onboarding new users into the QualityNet IT Services. Access is based on the list of approved services provided in the package.

FileCloud	Allows users to upload, download, and share contract-related files and documents while operating within the HCQIS cloud. GitHub	An open-source solution used by HCQIS to implement software configuration management (SCM). SCM helps in identifying individual elements and configurations, tracking changes, and version selection, control, and baselining. HARP also provides a single location for users to modify their user profile, change their password, update their challenge question, and add and remove two-factor authentication devices. Features include continuous integration and delivery environment for combinations of languages and source code repositories using pipelines, add-on plugins, and agile methodology. Managed File Transfer (MFT)	A managed file transfer solution that automates and secures file transfers using a centralized enterprise-level approach. MFT manages file transfer, file sharing, secure FTP, and automation needs through a single interface. Service Name	Description
QualityNet Accounts	All users requesting access to the QualityNet Secure Portal must be individually approved and verified. This mandatory registration process is used to maintain the confidentiality and security of healthcare information and data transmitted via the Secure Portal. The process begins with registration for a QualityNet account. The site also includes information regarding training and guides, known issues and maintenance, and QualityNet support.
QualityNet Atlassian	A cloud-based collaboration and planning service available to CMS, CMS contractors, and CMS stakeholders. QualityNet Slack	A digital-based collaboration platform that allows users to connect with individuals as well as groups within the HCQIS community using a variety of methods such as channels, direct messaging, voice calls, screen shares, and file sharing. ServiceNow	A backend ticketing tool used to report an incident or request support from the HCQIS Help Desk. ServiceNow accesses the Service Catalog, which informs users about available goods and services as well as empowers users to request services or products from IT. Users receive email notifications when a ticket is submitted through ServiceNow that includes the ticket reference number and status. The ServiceNow portal allows users to view the status and/or add comments to a request in real time. Splunk	The data collection backbone for security operations to create a unified, interoperable security operations capability across all data centers. Features include securing transfer of log files and audit data, obtaining data feeds via both push and pull methods, installing Windows and UNIX agent on a system to extract required data feeds in an ingestible format, allowing common access and views for shared operational awareness, creating custom analytics and behavioral models, and providing common alerting and reporting mechanism among data centers. ZScaler allows users access to resources within an internal network by using tunneling-to-transmit data between the client and desired resource. Access Type	Description
Enterprise User Administration (EUA) Accounts	<ul> <li>EUA is a system used by CMS to manage enterprise User IDs and passwords. It provides centralized administration of User IDs on the entire CMS enterprise including the mainframe systems, mid-tier devices such as AIX or Sunsystems, network operating systems such as Windows, and database platforms such as Oracle, Sybase, and MS SQL. The system utilizes online data to automate the approval process for access requests and provides logging and auditing support.</li> <li>If EUA Access is required, please read The Enterprise User Administration Access Approvers Guide on the CMS Intranet at <a href="http://intranet.cms.gov/Component/OAGM/Training/Training-Presentations-on-Various-Acquisition-Topics/EUA-Access-Approvers-Guide.pdf">http://intranet.cms.gov/Component/OAGM/Training/Training-Presentations-on-Various-Acquisition-Topics/EUA-Access-Approvers-Guide.pdf</a></li> <li>The CMS COR should work with the contractor to ensure that all the necessary security paperwork is completed (e.g., HHS 745, Application for Access to CMS Computer Systems, Security Training and PIV Training Certification). The CMS COR should ensure that the paperwork is submitted and processed so that the New Contractor has their access and badging completed within the dates of the transition timeline.</li> <li>An email should be sent to the new EUA users provided additional information including timeline, how to set up their password and how to choose job codes.</li> </ul>
