Dark Mode is Easier on the Eyes

One in four adults in the United States has a disability. Users with varying degrees of visual, cognitive, auditory, speech, and motor disabilities have vastly different experiences with the same content. To accommodate different users, QualityNet Slack works to be accessible to all. Today's Slack 508 Accessibility series topic is **Use Dark Mode For Easier Viewing**.

Darker, Higher Contrast

Dark mode helps make working in Slack easier on your eyes by using a darker, higher contrast color theme. You can turn on dark mode from your Slack **Preferences**, or sync dark mode in Slack with your operating system (OS) settings on certain devices.

Here's how to turn on dark mode:

- 1. Click your **profile picture** in the top right.
- 2. Select **Preferences** from the menu.
- 3. Choose Themes.
- 4. Select Dark.

That's It! Now just close out of Preferences.

**Dark Mode is Device Specific

The dark mode preference is device specific, so setting it on the desktop app won't apply to any government issued mobile device.

If you have a Mac or Windows, then the only change is in Step 4: After you choose **Themes**, check the box next to **Sync with OS setting**.

For Android

- 1. Tap the **You tab** at the bottom of the screen.
- 2. Tap Preferences.
- ${\it 3.} \quad {\it Select \mbox{\bf Dark Mode}, then choose \mbox{\bf System default}.}$
