Creating a HARP Account

For security reasons, all users are required to complete identity proofing to verify their identity.

SCENARIO #1 EIDM / EUA

If you have an active EIDM or EUA account, you may bypass registration and log into HARP directly with your EIDM or EUA credentials.

SCENARIO #2 Remote Proofing

Your identity is verified remotely via a series of personal questions.
