CDR Weekly Refresh Update

Please note below the data refreshes that occurred within the Centralized Data Repository (CDR) during the week of 7/26/2020 – 8/1/2020. For specific refresh dates of each source, please reference the CDR Data Catalog on <u>Confluence</u>. The following sources were refreshed:

CDR Hive Schema public data - compare_nursing_home public data - zip code legacy_provider_data legacy_hqr_hvbp qmars nch_part_a nch_part_b

The data refresh dates are published for awareness of data timeliness. If your organization requires data to be refreshed on a different timeline or cycle, please create a ServiceNow request for the "ADO-CDR-Support" and include details of your request including business justification, data source, requested refresh frequency, and requested refresh dates. The "Most Recent Refresh" refers to the date the data was extracted from the legacy database or source system. This data is typically available 24-48 hours after extraction. Beneficiary Information on the Cloud (BIC) Data – Available in CDR

The Data and Analytics Modernization team has granted access to the 'beneficiary_data' hive schema for organizations with approved access according to their CMS Data Use Agreement (DUA). Users can begin to access this data in the CDR today. This data will be the source of beneficiary data going forward within the CDR. We have also made available several artifacts for BIC data. These documents are posted to the CDR data catalog on Confluence.

Beneficiary Data Table Layouts – This document contains the table names, column names, and data types for BIC data within the CDR.

BIC-Data-Lake-Data-Dictionary – This is a data dictionary from BIC with further details on column names and descriptions of the tables.

The Data and Analytics Modernization team has planned to maintain a period of concurrent access to both legacy and future data sources within the CDR. This period of concurrent access will be approximately 60 days and will provide continued refreshes of legacy_beneficiary_data and legacy_sddw_np_sdps (Beneficiary and Provider tables) into October 2020. After this time, organizations are required to complete transitions onto the new sources. No legacy sources will be removed from the CDR without advanced notice.

CSAT Part D Data – Available in CDR

The Data and Analytics Modernization team has published CSAT Part D data to the CDR. The Part D 2-month baseline files (May 2018 – February 2020) can be found in CSAT_2 hive schema. The Part D 5-month baseline files (May 2018 – November 2019) can be found in CSAT_5 hive schema. Please refer to the CDR data catalog on Confluence for the latest refresh dates.

FileCloud Documentation Removal

The CCSQ Data and Analytics Confluence space is now internet facing. This means that any individual, with or without Atlassian or HARP accounts, can access all of our onboarding information, training documentation, Knowledge Base articles, Data Catalog Information, and other resources. Since all users can now access this space, the Confluence space is now the primary location for all of our documentation. Since FileCloud will no longer be a repository for documentation, all user documentation inside the QualityNet Analytics folder in FileCloud will be deleted on **August 10th**, to ensure that users always reference the most updated information.
