## **New Help Desk Email – Important Announcement!**

Effective immediately, the <a href="mailto:qnetsupport@hcqis.org">qnetsupport@hcqis.org</a> email, used to open Help Desk tickets, has been replaced by the new HCQIS Services and Support email (ServiceCenterSOS@cms.hhs.gov). Moving forward, please email the HCQIS Services and Support email in order to open Help Desk tickets and report incidents. Please do not direct your questions or issues to SAS Technical Services, as they will route you back toward the Data & Analytics Team.

### **CSAT Update**

On 1/27/2021, a discrepancy was reported in the CSAT Part D quantity\_dispensed field. Some records are incorrectly showing quantity\_dispensed=0 for September 2016 to June 2017. This issue does not impact the DDPS Part D source data. The issue is targeted to be resolved by 2/12/2021.

An additional issue has been reported impacting state code assignments for beneficiary state codes and provider state codes greater than '53'. This issue impacts Part A, Part B, and Part D files. Claims for the beneficiary and provider state numbers above '53' are not being assigned a state code to be included in CSAT. This issue is currently targeted to be resolved on 2/5/2021 for CSAT\_2 and CSAT\_5 files from 11/2018 to current. It is targeted to be resolved on 2/12/2021 for CSAT\_2 and CSAT\_5 files from 9/2016-10/2018.

## **QMARS Data Issue – Update**

On 12/16/2020, an issue was reported with QMARS data where updates were no longer occurring in the source QMARS schema. Data updates stopped occurring for many tables between September to December 2020. The QMARS ADO has worked to resolve this issue and updated data has been made available in the CDR.

#### **HQR Data Form Issue**

On 1/27/2021, a data discrepancy was identified in the quality\_measures\_hqr\_data\_form.iqr table in the CDR. The "payment\_year" column is incorrectly displaying calendar year. The column will be renamed to reflect "fiscal\_year" and the data will be corrected. The HQR ADO is working to resolve the issue and it is targeted to be resolved by 2/2/2021.

## **CDR Weekly Refresh Update**
