## Zeppelin Rollout Update – **Group 2 Onboarding Begins Today!**



The Data & Analytics Modernization Team will continue phased onboarding with Group Two today for the new CCSQ Application Platform (CAP) tool, Zeppelin. Zeppelin has been offered alongside SAS Viya to organizations working with the Centralized Data Repository (CDR). *Please note that Zeppelin is not replacing SAS Viya, as Zeppelin will be an additional tool within the CCSQ Data & Analytics environment and part of the CCSQ vision to increase the number of collaboration tools for utilization.*

The first group of organizations were provided onboarding instructions on Tuesday, May 25<sup>th</sup>. This morning, the second group of organizations were notified to begin onboarding and

requesting access to Zeppelin. The organizations within these groups submitted requests via the CCSQ Data & Analytics Request Form on Confluence and were selected based upon the priorities that the teams provided in their requests.

**Please note that once all initial organizations are successfully onboarded and working in the Production environment, the DAMOD Team plans to provide all QualityNet Analytics organizations the ability to onboard into Zeppelin on June 8<sup>th</sup>.** These other interested organizations would *not* need to fill out the request form on Confluence, as HARP roles will be available for them on that date to request. *If an organization is not interested in utilizing Zeppelin, no action is needed.*

1. Group 1 – Seven organizations began onboarding **May 25<sup>th</sup>**
2. Group 2 – Additional seven organizations begin onboarding **June 1<sup>st</sup>**
3. Group 3 – All other interested organizations can start onboarding **June 8<sup>th</sup>**

## CDR Data Issues Updates

The below list includes updates on current data issues within the Centralized Data Repository (CDR). Please monitor the [CDR Known Issues Log](#) for the latest statuses and targeted resolution dates.

Schema Name	Current Status
beneficiary_data	There is currently an open issue with Beneficiary Information on the Cloud (BIC) where MBIs overlap among multiple beneficiary keys for 63 cases. This affects the beneficiary_data schema in the CDR. BIC is currently working to correct this issue and will notify DAMOD when a target resolution date is available. Once the corrected data is available, the DAMOD team will refresh the data in the CDR.
csat_2, csat_5 (Part B)	An issue in processing and guidance on Part B claims data [CARRIER only] recently occurred that impacted CSAT data. Based on the mainframe data, the data changed to 4 header/segments per claim consisting

	<p>of up to 13 lines per header/segment [up to 50 lines total per claim] starting in August 2020.</p> <p>Updates to the CSAT code are being made to account for the segment change. The updates are planned to be incorporated into the 6/2/2021 refresh. CMS has approved a re-run of the impacted CSAT Part B data to correct historically impacted files and a date for availability will be provided as soon as possible.</p>
csat_2, csat_5 (Part B)	<p>The Part B Final Action logic in the CSAT code is not processing in the correct order to meet the requirement for a static data set with 2-month and 5-month maturity. The issue was discovered when a rerun of the full CSAT was performed and the final action process identified adjustments and replaced the static final claims. CMS has approved a re-run of the impacted CSAT Part B data to correct historically impacted files and a date for availability will be provided as soon as possible.</p>
csat_2, csat_5 (Part D)	<p>The Part D Final Action logic in the CSAT code is not processing in the correct order to meet the requirement for a static data set with 2-month and 5-month maturity. The issue was discovered when a rerun of the full CSAT was performed and the final action process identified adjustments and replaced the static final claims. CMS has approved a re-run of the impacted CSAT Part D data to correct historically impacted files and a date for availability will be provided as soon as possible.</p>
beneficiary_data	<p>The data owner has confirmed that the missing MBI issue persists after their 4/26/2021 fix. They are working to evaluate the scope of the missing MBIs and determine a plan for correction. The examples provided by the DAMOD team are under review with their SMEs.</p>
qmars	<p>Longer text fields in the QMARS data are currently being truncated in the source schema. This issue is universal for columns with a string data type that are greater than 32 characters long. No target date for resolution has been provided by the QMARS ADO.</p>
