### CDR Data Issues Updates

The below list includes updates on current data issues within the Centralized Data Repository (CDR). Please monitor the [CDR Known Issues Log](#) for the latest statuses and targeted resolution dates.

Schema Name	Current Status
resource_hqr_prs	The hlth_serv_provider table in this database currently has an issue with the rural/urban indicator. The Data Modernization team is working with the HQR team to

	determine an approach to provide accurate data in this column.
csat_2, csat_5	There is a current data issue with the CSAT 'bene_death_dt' column where new dates of death are not being updated. The CSAT team is performing an investigation to determine the scope of the impact. This issue is related to the recently identified issue with the PRS beneficiary merge process.
resource_hqr_prs_supplemental	<p>The Beneficiary merge code for PRS was found to have an issue where it isn't updating existing records and new data isn't being loaded properly into PRS. This was identified with death data originally sourced from BIC.</p> <p>The following tables are impacted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• resource_hqr_prs_supplemental.beneficiary</li> <li>• resource_hqr_prs_supplemental.bene_cross_reference</li> <li>• resource_hqr_prs_supplemental.entitlement_reason</li> <li>• resource_hqr_prs_supplemental.bene_migration</li> <li>• resource_hqr_prs_supplemental.bene_edb_mbi</li> <li>• resource_hqr_prs_supplemental.coverage</li> </ul> <p>The HQR ADO has worked to correct this merge code and pull anything that was missed since Nov 2020. The issue was targeted to be resolved by 9/1/2021. The Data Modernization team is reviewing the changes made by HQR to resolve the issue and will close it pending verification.</p>
qmars	There is an issue with QMARS data where the count of appeals in the CDR differs from the QMARS system. The QMARS ADO is working to investigate the issue and determine a resolution. Once the QMARS ADO corrects the data issue, the DAMOD team will pull the corrected data into the CDR.
qmars	Longer text fields in the QMARS data are currently being truncated in the source schema. This issue is universal for columns with a string data type that are greater than 32 characters long. No target date for resolution has been provided by the QMARS ADO.

## CDR CSAT Data

The CSAT team posted the August refresh for CSAT on Monday, August 30<sup>th</sup>. In this refresh, Part A and B changes were implemented to use the BIC data source for beneficiary information. Also, the missing NDC fields (ndc11 and product\_srvc\_id) were populated by the CSAT team.

The CSAT team also has updated the CSAT layouts and data dictionary, posting this information in the Data Catalog on Confluence. Please note that the Date of Death issue continues to be investigated and worked on by the team. The Known Issues Log will be updated with a resolution date once it is available.
