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## Where to Store Data/Files in SAS Viya

### Purpose

The following is a guide on where to store data and files within the SAS Viya environment.

### Best Practice

#### Code (i.e. SAS Code)

Store all code in the relevant organization [SAS Content folder](#).

#### Data (i.e., large SAS Datasets, PDF, txt, excel, csv)

Store all files of these types in the relevant [organization workbench folder](#).

Note: If users and their organization do not have access to the workbench folder, open a ServiceNow ticket to request access. Within the ticket, provide justification on why a large number of files need to be stored in these folders (i.e., purpose, type of files, etc.). The support team will work with CMS to provide a solution for users and their organization.

#### Tables

If users have data that needs to be stored in table format, they should store it in their [organization Hive database](#).

Users can save data to their organization hive database using the following:

```
PROC CASUTIL;  
  SAVE REPLACE  
  INCASLIB="mycaslib" CASDATA="claim_counts"  
  OUTCASLIB="mycaslib" CASOUT="claim_counts";  
RUN;
```
